## The venue and getting there

The venue for Congress 2018 is the: **Crowne Plaza, Liverpool City Centre hotel**, on the historic Waterfront in the buzzing centre of Liverpool.

Guests can park at the hotel for low daily rates. Liverpool Lime Street station is 20 minutes on foot. Liverpool John Lennon Airport (LPL) is a 20-minute drive. Manchester International Airport, with global connections, is 45 minutes by car or 1 hour direct by train.
